
Globe University/Minnesota School of Business Transfer Student Grant Terms and Conditions

AWARD

The Globe University/Minnesota School of Business Transfer Student Grant is a 15% tuition reduction off the total tuition for the entire duration of enrollment in a Kaplan University certificate, undergraduate, or graduate program.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS OVERVIEW

To receive the Grant, you must:

- Must be an enrollee in a certificate, undergraduate, or graduate degree program at Kaplan University; continuing students and enrollees in bachelor's and associate's degrees eligible for Kaplan University Tuition Cap pricing* are not eligible.
- Must meet all Kaplan University admissions requirements for the degree or certificate program, including GED or high school equivalent, and be fully accepted into one of the Kaplan University eligible online certificate, undergraduate, or graduate programs.
- Must have attended Globe University or Minnesota School of Business in the last 120 days but did not graduate; an unofficial transcript must be submitted prior to enrollment (online students) or prior to the end of the fourth week of the first term (campus and learning center students).[†]
- Must have achieved a cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of at least a 2.0 out of 4.0 on the submitted prior Globe University/Minnesota School of Business coursework that was reviewed and not accepted for transfer credit.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- If the unofficial transcript is not provided prior to enrollment (online students) or prior to the end of the fourth week (campus and learning center students), the student will not be eligible for the Globe University/Minnesota School of Business Transfer Student Grant and will be responsible for full tuition costs.
- Student must be continuously enrolled at Kaplan University. Students who withdraw will no longer be eligible for the Globe University/Minnesota School of Business Transfer Student Grant.
- The Grant applies to tuition only and does not apply to fees, books (for graduate programs), or any other charges.
- If the student meets all eligibility criteria to qualify, the Grant will be applied on the student ledger at the end of the term as a credit of 15% toward tuition. There is no tuition reduction for the first term after initial enrollment.
- The Grant cannot be used in conjunction with any other Kaplan University tuition reductions (including active-duty and veterans military tuition rates), grants, vouchers, or other scholarships, but not Tuition Cap pricing.
