COMPLETION RATE

This rate was calculated by ascertaining the number of all students who completed a program between July 1, 2011 and June 30, 2012, and then determining the number of those students who completed the program within "normal time." Normal time is defined as the amount of time necessary for a student to complete all requirements for the degree or certificate as provided in the institution's catalog or other promotional materials. For example, this is two years for an associate's degree program and four years for a bachelor's degree program.
