According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, the health care industry is expected to grow much faster than the average for all occupations between 2014 and 2024, due, in part, to an aging population and an increase in the number of Americans with access to health insurance.² This is expected to create new opportunities within the industry, and not all of today's health care jobs require patient contact. Medical billing and coding is an administrative support specialty that is expected to increase in need as baby boomers demand more medical services and become eligible for Social Security and Medicare.
