#### Tuition

Tuition for the Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) is \$385.00 per quarter credit hour; tuition for the Doctor in Nursing Practice (DNP) is \$700.00 per quarter credit hour. Any questions, comments, or concerns regarding the current tuition rate and/or changes to tuition rates are to be directed to Financial Aid. A change in program may not constitute a change in tuition. Active-duty servicemembers are eligible for a 20 percent tuition reduction on doctorate program tuition, veterans are eligible for a 15 percent reduction on doctorate program tuition, and spouses of active-duty servicemembers are eligible for a 10 percent reduction on doctorate program tuition.

#### Fees

##### **Deposits**

A nonrefundable deposit of \$25.00 is required at the time of reenrollment for returning students. Once the student begins classes, the deposit will be credited to the first term's tuition.

##### **Technology**

All students are required to pay a \$295.00 technology fee per term (\$200.00 for U.S. military servicemembers, veterans, and military spouses).

##### **Additional Technology Requirements for Courses**

Along with the Technology Requirements listed in the Catalog, all students should review and be aware of any additional software and hardware requirements for their classes prior to enrollment. ##### **Transcripts**

A fee of \$10.00 is charged for each copy of an official transcript. A \$2.00 shipping and handling fee will be charged if the receiving school is unable to accept electronic delivery. Additional fees are as follows: notarized, \$30.00; rush delivery, \$25.00. Students will receive one free copy of their official diploma. Additional fees are as follows: duplicate/replacement, \$25.00 (free if damaged in shipment or printed with errors); notarized, \$30.00; apostille, \$100.00.

##### **Additional Fees**

A \$10.00 fee will be added for all returned checks. Refer to the Areas of Study section for program- and course-specific fees. Unless otherwise noted, these fees may be paid using financial aid funds and can be incorporated into the student's monthly payment plan.

## Policies

- Books and other instructional materials are not included; some courses may require students to purchase additional course materials from another source.
- Not all programs are available in all states. Check with an Admissions Advisor.
- Tuition and fees are subject to change after 30 days' advance notice. See the current University Catalog/Addendum for an explanation of the Refund Policy.
- Tuition is payable in full every term. Tuition payments can be made at the following website: [kaplanuniversity.edu](http://kaplanuniversity.edu). Log on to KU Campus and select the "Make Payment" link.
- Failure to return library materials to Kaplan University or any of its partner libraries will result in a financial obligation to Kaplan University and may result in postponement of registration for a new term or graduation.
- Students whose highest degree earned is a Bachelor of Science in Nursing will first earn a Master of Science in Nursing before beginning the Doctor of Nursing Practice program.
- Prior to enrollment in the Doctor of Nursing Practice, students must submit an unofficial transcript indicating receipt of a master's degree in nursing from a college or university accredited by a regional or national accrediting agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education. The Master of Science in Nursing must be accredited by a nursing programmatic accreditor. By the last day of the first term, students must provide the University with an official copy of the transcript. If an official transcript is not submitted by the last day of the first term, the student will be withdrawn from the University and blocked from reentry, and the student's academic credentials will be withheld until such documentation is provided. Furthermore, all Title IV financial aid or any state or institutional funding must be refunded to the appropriate source, and the student will be responsible for payment of these funds to the original source or to Kaplan University.
- Cancellation of Enrollment Agreement:** Three-Day Cancellation—An applicant who provides written notice of cancellation within three days (excluding Saturday, Sunday, and federal and state holidays) of signing an Enrollment Agreement is entitled to a refund of all monies paid.

The final cost varies based on the program of study, the rate at which the student completes the program of study, cost of books and supplemental materials, availability of eligible prior learning credits, prerequisites required, and the fees set forth in this document.

**Program Fees:** Nurse practitioner students and doctoral students will pay a fee of \$350.00 per clinical course. Online students enrolled in the **Master of Science in Nursing** or a **School of Nursing certificate program** are required to submit criminal background checks. Students will be required to have an approved criminal background check from the Kaplan University approved vendor on file: (1) prior to the first day of the first term (the fee is \$48.00 and is the responsibility of the student to pay the vendor directly where applicable); (2) prior to registering for practicum or clinical courses if the original check expires prior to or during the practicum or clinical courses (the fee is \$33.00 and is the responsibility of the student where applicable). **Nurse practitioner and doctoral students** will have no more than four (4) clinical course requirements in their plan of study. Each course will be assessed a fee of \$350.00. The following courses are charged the clinical course fee: master's courses—MN 560, MN 561, MN 562, MN 599, MN 569, MN 573, MN 577, MN 581, MN 585, and MN 610; doctoral courses—DN 720, DN 730, DN 810, DN 820, DN 723, DN 803, DN 813, and DN 823.
