
Kaplan University/ThanksUSA Scholarship Terms and Conditions

AWARD

In honor of the commitment and sacrifice made by our military and their families, Kaplan University is proud to offer several scholarships through ThanksUSA for eligible military spouses and dependents.

Between May 15, 2017, and October 31, 2017, the Kaplan University/ThanksUSA Scholarship program will award up to 10 partial-tuition scholarships and 15 full-tuition scholarships to qualified students to complete an associate's or bachelor's degree at Kaplan University. Kaplan University will notify each recipient directly of their award.

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY

Recipients will be chosen by ThanksUSA based on:

- Completion of application and submission of all appropriate documentation,
- Verification of status as a qualifying military spouse or dependent, and
- Verification of qualifying Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA).

TYPES OF AWARDS

Partial Scholarships

Kaplan University/ThanksUSA Scholarship applicants must have a CGPA of 3.00 or higher (on a 4.00 scale) from high school or prior college.

Kaplan University will award five (5) partial-tuition scholarships to military spouses who are licensed registered nurses and want to enhance their education by earning their Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN). Applicants must provide a copy of their current nursing license.

Kaplan University will award five (5) partial-tuition scholarships to military spouses and dependent children who currently hold an associate's degree and would like to earn their bachelor's degree online through Kaplan University.

The Kaplan University/ThanksUSA Partial Scholarship provides partial tuition coverage, allowing recipients to attend Kaplan University for \$195.00 per quarter credit hour. The tuition reduction ranges from 38% to 47%, depending on the program. The full tuition for most undergraduate degrees is \$371.00 per quarter credit hour; this scholarship would reduce the net tuition to \$195.00 per quarter credit hour—a 47% tuition reduction (based on full tuition cost). The full tuition for the eligible nursing program (Bachelor of Science in Nursing) is \$315.00 per quarter credit hour; this scholarship would reduce the net tuition to \$195.00 per quarter credit—a 38% tuition reduction (based on full tuition cost). All recipients will have technology fees of \$200.00 per term for A, B, and C terms, and \$100.00 for D terms. Technology fees are waived for U.S. military servicemembers.

The scholarship can be used only toward the cost of program tuition (it does not cover any fees) at Kaplan University for an associate's or bachelor's degree. Recipients are not eligible for other Kaplan University discounts, scholarships, grants or tuition vouchers, including military, alliance relationship reductions, or Kaplan University Tuition Cap pricing. All Kaplan University/ThanksUSA scholarships are in the form of tuition discounts and have no cash equivalent.

Recipients may receive financial aid and outside scholarships not funded by Kaplan University.

Full Scholarships

Kaplan University/ThanksUSA applicants must have a CGPA of 3.00 or higher (on a 4.00 scale) from high school or prior college.

Kaplan University will award total of fifteen (15) full-tuition ThanksUSA/Kaplan University scholarships based on applications received to eligible students in the following areas:

- Military spouses and dependent children toward a 4-year bachelor's degree.
- Military spouses who are licensed registered nurses and want to enhance their education by earning a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN). Students must provide a copy of their current nursing license.
- Military spouses and dependent children who currently hold an associate's degree and would like to earn their bachelor's degree online through Kaplan University.

The full-scholarship award will cover the full cost of an associate's or bachelor's degree program to include tuition, fees (technology, clinical, course assessments, etc.), and materials at Kaplan University.

Recipients are not eligible for other Kaplan University discounts, scholarships, grants, or tuition vouchers, including military, alliance relationship reductions, or Kaplan University Tuition Cap pricing. All Kaplan University/ThanksUSA scholarships are in the form of tuition discounts and have no cash equivalent.

Recipients may receive financial aid and outside scholarships not funded by Kaplan University.
