Welcome New Members

Meg Pugh

Student Interaction with the SAB Update

Camie Ayash

- Camie shared that Matt Braslow, Director of Assessment and Research, will be joining the November meeting to speak about updates to the end of term survey, and it may be possible for the SAB to add a question to that survey. She encouraged board members to email her ideas for a survey question.
- Camie explained that some of her professors had not heard of the SAB and members should reach out to their professor and encourage them to promote the SAB within the classroom. She suggested also reaching out to the heads of departments to help spread the word and encourage others to support the SAB.
 - Sampling of that feedback:
 - Whitney asked if the survey question will be short answer or multiple choice. Camie replied that it may be easier for them to evaluate the data if the question was multiple choice.
 - Zachary suggested asking students what type of resources they wished they had to assist with their classes.
 - Jennifer offered to assist with the creation of an email template to send to professors. Jackie reminded the board that Brianne created a flyer that could also be included.

 - Whitney stated that having more examples of classroom assignments would be helpful.
 - Jennifer commented that the discussion boards are not as effective as they could be. Zachary suggested that long, open-ended questions could count as posts.
