Employment Rates

Kaplan University calculates job employment rates for its ground campuses to ensure that its students are succeeding beyond graduation. Kaplan University campuses are located in Cedar Falls, Cedar Rapids, Council Bluffs, Davenport, Des Moines, Mason City, Lewiston, South Portland, Hagerstown, Lincoln, and Omaha. Job employment rates for some, but not all, programs may also be calculated for accreditation and state regulatory purposes.

All programs must report employment rates. There is a variety of reasons some programs report zero percent employment rates even though there may have been graduates in the program. For example, some graduate have chosen to continue their education, have pursued other job opportunities outside of their field of study, were not able to obtain employment within their field of study, or are not currently seeking employment.

The Medical Assistant Program is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Educational Programs upon the recommendation of the Medical Assisting Education Review Board. This accreditor requires the calculation of employment placement rates. The rate is calculated as the percentage of graduates from the year ending 12/31/11 who was employed in a related field, continuing education, or serving in the military as of November 24th in the year following their graduation. The established placement threshold for this accreditor is 60%.

Kaplan University calculates internal employment rates to ensure that its students are succeeding beyond graduation. Those rates are calculated as the number of students who graduated between 7/1/11 to 6/30/12 and were employed by 12/31/12 divided by the total number of students who graduated between 7/1/11 to 6/30/12 and were available for employment. Graduates available for employment are those graduates who do not have employment waiver or are not otherwise unavailable for employment for reasons including health related, issues, pregnancy, continuing education and military service
