## Employment Rates

Kaplan University Learning Center - Milwaukee calculates graduate employment numbers to ensure that its students are succeeding beyond graduation.

The Wisconsin Educational Approval Board requires KU – Online to calculate graduate employment numbers for students that reside in Wisconsin. These numbers are according to a specific, time-limited period as prescribed by the state regulator. The numbers below reflect only the graduates who were placed within the applicable time period, and do not include graduates placed outside of that specific timeframe.

Exclusions allowed by the Wisconsin Educational Approval Board are limited to continuing education. This segment of KU Online students used the KU Learning Center in Milwaukee during their program.

<sup>2</sup> Rates are calculated as the number of students who graduated between 7/1/2011 and 6/30/2012 and were employed by 12/31/2012. The Wisconsin Educational Approval Board requires Kaplan University to submit employment numbers for a twelve month period ending June 30, but KU Career Services provides ongoing employment assistance to graduates beyond that date. Exclusions allowed by Kaplan University include continuing education, death, health/medical conditions, incarceration, international student with I-20, military, public-service obligations and voluntary unemployment.

<sup>3</sup> Rates are calculated as the number of students who graduated between 7/1/2011 and 6/30/2012 and were employed by 6/30/2012. Exclusions allowed by the Wisconsin Educational Approval Board are limited to continuing education.
